We write to confirm our agreement relating to the publication of the paper, details of which are set out below ("**the Paper**"), in *Neuropsychanalysis* ("**the Journal**") as follows:

- 1 You grant to us the exclusive licence throughout the world for the entire period of copyright in the Paper and all extensions, reversions, revivals and renewals thereof, and thereafter, insofar as you are able, in perpetuity to reproduce, print, publish, make available and communicate to the public and otherwise distribute the Paper by all means and in all media whether now known or hereafter discovered or developed.
- 2 We reserve the right to edit, copy, add to, take from, adapt or translate the Paper as we see fit and, in respect of the Paper, you irrevocably waive the benefits of and agree not to assert any provision of law known as "moral rights" or any similar laws of any jurisdiction.
- 3 Following publication of the Paper in the Journal, we will send you one free hard copy of the edition of the Journal in which the Paper appears and an electronic Adobe PDF copy of the Paper.
- 4 You warrant that you are entitled to grant to us the rights referred to in paragraph 1 above and that the exercise of such rights will not infringe the copyright or any other personal or property rights of any person or entitle any person to claim any payment from us or from any of our licensees.
- 5 You warrant that the Paper does not contain any statement that is abusive, defamatory, libellous, obscene or fraudulent and that the Paper is not in any other way unlawful or in violation of applicable laws.
- 6 You warrant that the Paper is original in you, that no part of it has previously been published and that if the Paper contains any material created or owned by others (whether text, tables or illustrations), you have obtained all necessary written permissions from such others to enable us to exercise the rights granted to us under this agreement, have given appropriate credit to such persons in the Paper as submitted to us and have paid the relevant fees. You shall include copies of the relevant permissions with the copy of the Paper submitted to us under this agreement.
- 7 If the Paper was prepared jointly with other authors, you confirm that you have been authorised by all co-authors to sign this agreement on their behalf.
- 8 You agree to do all such deeds and execute all such documents as we may reasonably require for the purpose of confirming to the rights granted and/or purported to be granted to us under this agreement or giving effect to the intention of this agreement.
- 9 You confirm that you have no proprietary, financial, professional or other personal interest of any nature or kind in any product, service and/or company that could be construed as influencing the Paper or the review process. If you have any financial interest or benefit arising from the application of your research, you undertake to include an appropriate statement in the Paper.

- 10 When reporting research on human subjects you confirm that appropriate local, national and international ethical and safety guidelines have been adhered to in the research and the procedures followed were in accordance with the Helsinki Declaration of 1975, as revised in 2000 (5). When reporting experiments on animals you must indicate whether the institutional and national guidelines for the care and use of laboratory animals were followed.
- 11 Participants and patients have a right to privacy that should not be infringed without informed consent, and any identifying information should not be published. Informed consent should be obtained in writing if there is any doubt. If identifying characteristics are altered to protect anonymity, you must confirm in writing that alterations do not distort scientific meaning.
- 12 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this agreement, you shall be entitled without requiring our permission to use figures and tables included in the Paper and up to 10% of the text of the Paper in future works, lectures, press releases or reviews. For longer extracts permission should be sought from the publisher of the Journal, acting on our behalf.
- 13 You shall indemnify us and the editors and publisher of the Journal in full against all damages, injury, loss, costs and expenses, including legal and other professional fees and expenses, awarded against or incurred by us as a result of your breach of any of the warranties given and/or obligations undertaken by you in this agreement.
- 14 This agreement, and any dispute or legal action relating to it, is subject to English law and the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales.
